



FEEE Funding Policy

March 2022

Olivers Lodge aims to offer FEEE funding, both 15 hours and the extended 15 hours entitlement, to our children in line with Essex County Council guidelines. These can be found in the parent agreement form on the following link <https://eycp.essex.gov.uk/funding/free-early-education-entitlement-for-three-to-four-year-olds/>

Parents are free to choose whether their child uses these hours term time only over 38 weeks or stretched over 51 weeks of the year; there are no restrictions on the number of days or hours when you take your FEEE offer, for example it can be used for up to 10 hours per day and we do not limit the amount of FEEE places available. We do have a consumables charge that is a charge for meals, consumables and additional activities, this is a voluntary charge, it is not mandatory.

Any extra hours will be charged at our hourly rate, full details of this can be found on our website www.olivers-lodge.co.uk. These are reviewed annually and will be updated where necessary.
